Stay calm on GCSE results day 2017

On results day you will receive a Candidate Statement of your Provisional Results. This statement will detail all your results from examinations taken and completed controlled assessments. Make sure you pack your mobile phone so you can give your parents/carer a call after getting your results.



Decide where you want to open your GCSE results

It's best to be at the academy to open your results, so you can get advice from your teachers, if you need it - but you can take your results home to open them if you prefer.

Make sure you are not peer-pressured into opening your results in front of your friends, especially if you are not feeling comfortable or confident.

What to do if you are unable to collect your results

If you are unable to collect your results, they can be posted to you, if you send in to the academy a stamped self-addressed envelope. Or, if you would prefer someone else to collect your results for you, you will need to send in a letter stating who will be collecting them and that person will need to bring ID with them when they collect your results
